- Tinnitus

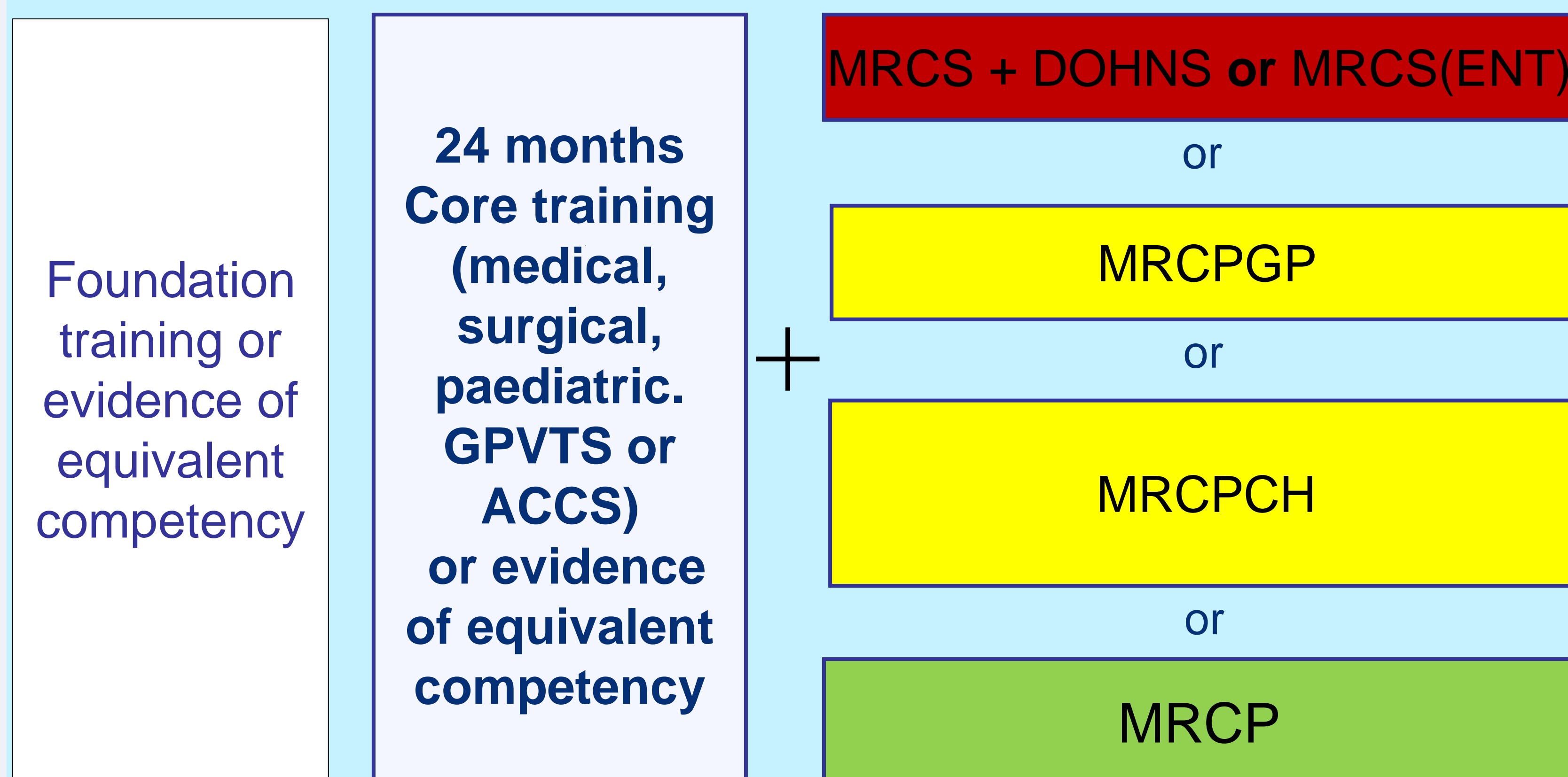

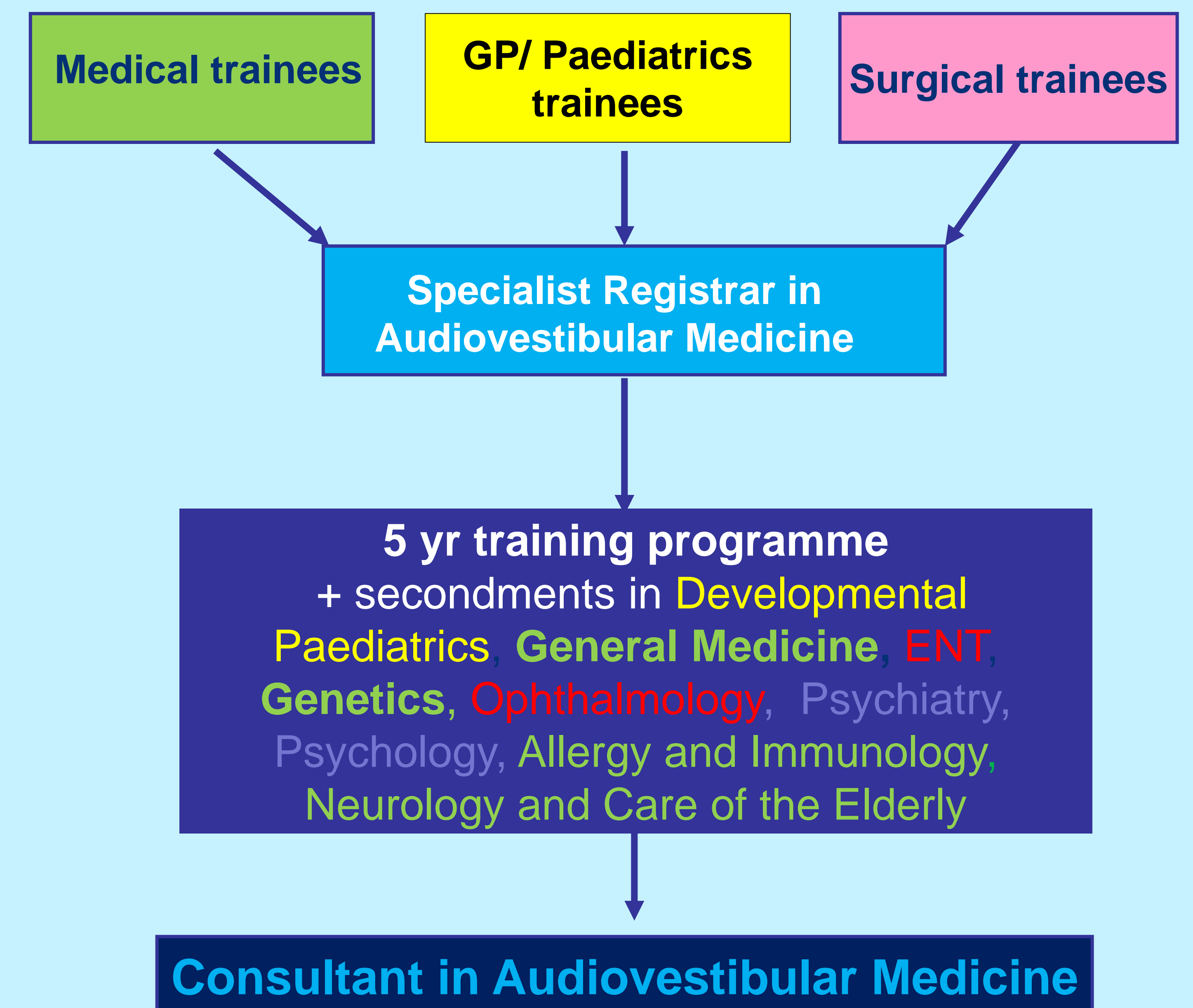
